# Twin Cities Grand Ball 2018

## 1 MRS STEWART'S JIG J32 · 3/4L

Frans Ligtmans: RSCDS XXXV 1 · Crib: E-cribs

- 1- 1c set | 1W casts, 1M following, round 3W, 1W dances up round 3M and 1M dances up the middle, 1c face 3c (2c up on 7-8) (2,1x,3)
- 9- 2c+1c+3c G-Chain (2c cross), 2M+1M finish facing out
- **17** 2c+1c L-Chain
- **25-** 2c+1c+3c A&R; 1c turn RH 1½ to (2,1,3)

## 2 THE HIGHLAND LASS R32 · 3/4L

Playford: RSCDS XXX 3 · Crib: E-cribs

- 1- 1c dance in touching NH & cast off (2c up); ½Reels3 across (w up, M down)
- 9- 1c dance between 3c and cast up on opposite sides; ½Reels3 across (M up, W down)
- **17-** 2c+1c R&L
- 25- 1c dance down between 3c and cast up; 2c+1c+3c turn RH

### 3 MIDSUMMER COMMON S32 · 3/4L

Tom & Lindsey Ibbotson: RSCDS XLIX  $3 \cdot \text{Crib}$ : Ecribs

- 1- 1c set | turn RH 1/2; lead down, cross below 3c (2c up on [5–6] and cast to 2pl (2,1,3)
- 9- 1c set adv to into BtoB facing 1cr while 1cr set | turn 1cnr BH into lines across; 1c set adv to into BtoB facing 2cr while 2cr set | turn 2cnr BH
- 17- 2c+1M & 1W+3c circle3 L, at end 1c swivels R to face P; 1c set | 1c Petronella turn (to 2,1,3)
- **25** 1c+2c poussette

## **4 RORY O'MORE** J32 · 2/4L

RSCDS I 9 · Crib: E-cribs

- 1- 1c+2c A&R; all cross NHJ, the M making the arch | keeping hands joined change places on the sides, 2c passing outside as 1c twirls under the joined hands (2x,1x)
- **9–** 2c+1c A&R; all cross NHJ, the W making the arch | change places on the sides as before, 2c again passing outside (1,2)
- 17- 1c lead down the middle and up
- **25–** 1c+2c Poussette (2,1)

Option: on [8] and [16] the turns under joined hands may be omitted.

## **5 HANA** \$32 \cdot 3/4L

Alex Gray: Tweeddale Collection, Volume 4 · Crib: E-cribs

- 1- 1c cross down RH | cast behind 3c; cross up RH | cast up to top
- 9- All turn RH; Turn LH
- 17- 1c+2c "The Helix" [set passing Lsh | cast R to own side; turn ½ RH into ½ RHA] (2,1,3)
- **25** All Circle6 and back

### **6 THE AUSTRALIAN LADIES** R32 · 3/4L

Robert M Campbell: Glasgow Assembly And Other Scottish Dances · Crib: E-cribs

- 1- 1c cross RH | cast off two (2c+3c up); 3c+1c RHA
- 9- 1c lead to top, cross and cast to 2pl (3c down); 2c+1c LHA (2,1,3)
- 2c+3c ("corners") set and change place RH four times following the track of R&L (3M&2W make polite turns) while{16} 1c cross (across or up/dn) RH and cast R round the corner four times.

Note by the deviser in TacTalk of jan. 1986: on [17-32] the corners set "as written"; they do not split the setting as is customary in "J.B. Milne".

#### **7 ALAN J SMITH** J32 · 3/4L

Andrew Smith: RSCDS XLV 3 · Crib: E-cribs

- 1- 1c set | dance down the middle and out through 2pl (2c up); 1M+3M & 1W+3W turn EH into DTr position (1c briefly join NH)
- 9- 2c+1c+3c DTr, at end 1c turn R about to face 1cnr
- 17- Turn CPCP, but at the end cross RH to (2,1,3)
- **25** All Circle6 and back (2,1,3)

## 8 GLEN ORRIN STRATHSPEY S32 · 4S

Ann & Ian Jamieson: The Glen Orrin Collection · Crib: MiniCribs

- 1-8 1s+3s dance R&L while 2s+4s set & cross RH, set & cross back RH all end facing corners
- 9-16 All set to corners, turn 2H, set to partners & turn 2H
- **17-24** All Set+Link with partners, Set+Link with corners (all are now opposite partners)
- 25-32 2s+4s (in 1st/3rd pstns) dance 1/2 Ladies Chain, 1s+3s dance 1/2 Ladies Chain to end with 2s at top

## 9 ORPINGTON CALEDONIANS R32 · 3/4L

John Brenchley: RSCDS XLIX 2 · Crib: E-cribs

- 1- 1c set | 1W followed by 1M cast off 1pl (2c up on 5–6) and cross | 1c+3c turn LH  $\frac{1}{2}$  on sidelines (1M+3M face out) (2,3,1x)
- 9- 3c+1c L-Chain (1M face out)
- 17- 1M followed by 1W cast up (3c down on 19-20) and cross; 2c+1c RHA (1M+2W face out) (2,1,3)
- **25** Reels3 on the sides, 1c Lsh to 3c (2,1,3)

#### **10 THE CHEQUERED COURT** J32 · 3/4L

Duncan Brown: RSCDS XLII 3 · Crib: E-cribs

- 1- 1c cross RH | cast off (2c up); ½ Fig8 across to the R (1M up, 1W down) to face 1cnr
- 9- 1c+1cnrs pass and turn, at end 1c swivels R to be BtoB facing 4cnr; 1c+4cnrs pass and turn, 1c swivels R to finish BtoB facing own side for
- 17- DTr, 1c finish between end couple facing own side
- **25** Reels3(6) across (Rsh to 4cnr) | 1c cross RH (2,1,3)

### 11 THE BRAES OF BREADALBANE \$32 \cdot 3/4L

Thomas Skillern: RSCDS XXI 7 · Crib: E-cribs

- 1- 1c Turn RH, cast off (2c up); turn LH, 1M/1W cast L (down/up) to between 3c/2c
- 9- Set twice in lines of 3 across; 1c cast back and Turn RH to (2,1,3)
- 17- All set twice in sidelines; turn partners BH
- **25-** 2c+1c R&L

#### **12 BRATACH BANA** R32 · 3/4L

John Drewry: Thirty Popular Dances, Volume Two · Crib: E-cribs

- 1- 1c turn RH | cast off (2c up); ½ Fig8 to R around 1cnr (to 2,1x,3)
- 9- ½Reel3 on sides (Rsh to 2cnr); ½Reel3 across (Lsh to 3cnr position), finish on sides (3x,1,2x)
- 17- 1c turn ¾ LH, Turn 1cnr person (3cnr position) RH; pass Rsh, turn 2cnr person (4cnr position) ¾ RH to promhold (cnr on the right)
- These pairs change places Rsh | drop LH and turn RH ½ to sidelines; half diagonal R&L (1st diagonal direction)

Note: [27–28] was originally 2 PdB in promhold.

#### **13 THE GRASSMARKET REEL** R32 · 3+3RR

Tim Wilson: Magazine Dances 2005-2009 · Crib: Ecribs

Trio face Trio RR

- 1- All Circle6 and back
- 9- Middle dancers RHA with dancers on their R; repeat with LHA to the L
- 17- The four corner dancers A&R diagonally; the middle dancers dance BtoB
- 25- All cross RH to opposite, to meet new trio | repeat LH : turn next opposite RH

#### 14 ASILOMAR ROMANTIC S32 · 3/4L

 $\textit{Tom Cuthbertson: Thirty Popular Dances, Volume Two} \cdot \textit{Crib: E-cribs}$ 

- 1- 1c+3c DblFig8 round 2c, to begin 1c crosses down, 3c casts up
- **9–** 1c+2c Poussette
- 17- 1c dance in and down one and face P (2c up) | set; dance Rsh round 4cnr to face 1cnr
- **25-** SetH&G (to 2,1,3)

### **15 THE CRANBERRY TART** J32 · 3/4L

Terry Glasspool: Thirty Popular Dances, Volume Two · Crib: Ecribs

- 1-16 Fugue: 1M set | cast (2M up); set | petronella to between 3c;; set with 3c | advance with 3c; retire with 3c | advance alone while{16} 1W waits {2} and then repeats 1M's [1-14], dancing with 2c, on [16] 1W pivots R to give Rsh to 2W
  - 17- 1W with 1M following Reel3 across with 2c, finish (2,1,3)
  - 25- Parallel Reels3 on own sides, 1c Rsh to 3c (2,1,3)

### **16 THE MERCAT CROSS** S32 · 3/3L

John Bowie Dickson: Dunedin Dances Book 3 · Crib: E-cribs

- **1-4** 1c+3c set, Petronella Turn
- 5-12 ½Reel4 on the midline, at end 1M+3W pass LH; 1M+2c+3W LHA while{4} 1W+3M chase clw to change places
- **13–20** repeat 5–12, end facing partners
- 21-24 1c+3c 11/4 turn RH, finishing 1c RHJ facing 2c NHJ and 3c on the side for
  - 25- 1c+2c Rondel, but on [29-32] 3c set advancing, make arch and dance to 2pl as 1c dance to 3pl

## 17 PELORUS JACK J32 · 3/4L

Barry Skelton: RSCDS XLI 1 · Crib: E-cribs

- 1- 1c cross RH, cast (2c up); 1c+3c RHA, finish 1M facing 1cnr, 1W behind him
- 1c in tandem +1cnrs ½ diagonal Reel3, Rsh to 3W (1M & 1W loop R singly for lead change, so 1W now leads P); ½ diagonal Reel3, Rsh to 2W (+ lead change)
- 17 Continue pattern twice
- 25- 2c+1c LHA; 1c turn LH ½ | all set (2,1,3)

#### **18 BAULDY BAIN'S FIDDLE** R32 · 3/4L

John Bowie Dickson: The Lothian Collection · Crib: E-cribs

- 1- 1c turn RH | cast (2c up); turn LH 1½ and face out (2,1x,3)
- 9- 1c dance cclw half round the set **while** 2c+3c RHA (2,1,3); 1c turn LH 1¼ to face 1cnr **while** cnrs chase ½ clw (3x, 1 in middle, 2x)
- 17- 1c ½ Reel4 with 1cnrs pass Rsh; ½ Reel4 with 2cnrs (2,1,3)
- **25** Circle6 and back
